- Una comida (cocina coreana) en la cafetería cuesta 7.000 KRW.\* Para otras dietas como la Halal/Kosher y la vegetariana puedes compartir la cocina
- El espacio para cocinar fuera de la habitación del dormitorio se asignará en un tiempo limitado, cada uno debe conseguir los ingredientes necesarios, el ideal es que puedas compartir
- Se dispone de frigoríficos de conservación fuera de los dormitorios.
- La oficina está en un pueblo remoto del condado de Buan.
- La terminal de autobuses está a 50 minutos de la oficina en autobús.
- El condado de Buan es pequeño y se encuentra situado en el suroeste de Corea
- Su población es de unos 50.000 habitantes y pertenece a la provincia de Jeollabuk-do.
